**Subject:- Submission of deficient documents of claims of sugar mills relating to Export Subsidy Schemes viz. "Assistance to Sugar Mills for 2019-20 SS". Scheme for "Assistance to Sugar Mills for 2020-21 SS"; and Buffer subsidy schemes-reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to say that few documents of some sugar mills under the above mentioned schemes to facilitate export of sugar and for maintaining buffer stocks are still missing. It may be noted that deficient documents including UCs for settlement of pending claims for respective schemes shall be submitted before 10.03.2022 so that file can be processed in the current Financial Year i.e. 2021-22.

2. Further, it is advised that, in case payment of the claim of any sugar mill under any of the above mentioned schemes is pending, the relevant schemes in the PFMS shall be added at the earliest. Those sugar mills which are facing issues in adding their corresponding schemes due to various reasons may send an email at [cgsugar.fpd@nic.in](mailto:cdsugar.fpd@nic.in) and [dtesug.fpd@nic.in](mailto:dtesug.fpd@nic.in) and resolve their issues at the earliest. Further, the sugar mills which have submitted their claims through online mode shall also submit the original pre-receipted bill preferably by 10.03.2022, so as to enable this Directorate of Sugar & Vegetable Oils to process and settle their claims in this Financial Year only.
