Subject: Clarification regarding combined Export Release Order for sugar mills where sugar mills are having stock of raw sugar as per online P-II and have requested /applied for Export Release Order.

Madam/Sir,

Please refer to the Directorate of Sugar's Export Release Order No-1 of even number dated 05.08.2022 vide which Directorate of Sugar has issued ERO to Sugar mills to export the allocated quantity of raw sugar themselves or through exporters.

2. Raw sugar is either directly exported or after value addition of such raw sugar by refinery it is exported in the form of refined sugar. Therefore, it is clarified that the customs authorities may allow exports of raw sugar or refined sugar manufactured from such raw sugar by the refinery/ sugar mill/ exporter. Such refinery/sugar mills which have procured raw sugar from the sugar mill within the quantity mentioned against the name of the raw sugar manufacturer in the ibid ERO dated 05.08.2022 are allowed to export refined sugar on producing relevant contract and invoice between the raw sugar manufacturers and refined sugar manufacturers.
