**ORDER**

In exercise of powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955) read with clause 4 and 5 of the Sugar (Control) Order, 1966 and Order S.O. No.2347 (E) dated 07.06.2018, stock holding limit for the month of July, 2022 was issued vide order dated 30.06.2022. In view of the unprecedented and unfortunate situation arisen due to inadequate availability/restriction of transportation and heavy rain, it has been decided to extend the time period for the monthly sale quota of sugar for July, 2022 by one month i.e. till 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2022.

2. Any violation of this order would attract the penal provisions under the Essential Commodities Act, 1955, as amended from time to time.
